
#### 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 This report deals with Personnel Policies and Procedures for employees of the Valuation Joint Board.

1.2 A review of Personnel Policies and Procedures is in progress. Until this is completed, an interim procedure for dealing with grading appeals arising in the Service is required.

#### 2. DELEGATION

- 2.1 The Scheme of Delegation to Officers was approved by the Valuation Joint Board on 15<sup>th</sup> February 1996. This scheme delegates to officers the appointment of employees up to the level of Head of Service.
- 2.2 The scheme delegates to the Assessor the authority to determine gradings or re-gradings of posts and to review or amend staffing structures within the limits of existing employee budgets and total establishment.
- 2.3 Any officer to whom delegated powers have been granted may authorise other officers to exercise such powers in their absence.



### 3. GRADING MATTERS

- 3.1 The delegated power to deal with grading and re-grading of staff is exercised within the Service. Disputes about gradings or re-gradings should, therefore also be contained within the Service.
- 3.2 Where gradings or re-gradings have been determined by officers within the service, appeals and disputes about grading will be heard by the Assessor.
- 3.3 There may be occasions where the Assessor has been involved in determining or approving grading or re-grading of staff. The Assessor cannot hear grading appeals in this instance.

# 4. CONSIDERATION OF CERTAIN APPEALS

4.1 Where the Assessor is unable to hear grading appeals, disputes or grievances relating to grading the Clerk and/or the Treasurer will be the appropriate officers to hear the appeals or deal with the disputes. Advice will be provided by Personnel & Training Services, Clackmannanshire Council.

### 5. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Valuation Joint Board approves the report submitted by the Assessor and amends the Scheme of Delegation to the extent that the Clerk and/or Treasurer of the Valuation Joint Board be delegated to deal with any outstanding appeals of gradings or re-gradings where the Assessor is unable to act.
