

Performance Report 2001-2002




Valuation Roll:


During the year 1279 statutory amendments were made to the Valuation Roll. Of these, 613 (48%) were made within 3 months of the effective date of the alteration and 949 (74%) were made within 6 months

The target set for the year was 45% within 3 months and 70% within 6 months.

The targets set for 2002/2003 are 49% and 75% respectively.

During the year the number of entries in the Valuation Roll fell from 11,977 to 11,928 and the total rateable value rose from £192.8M to £193.8M.





Electoral Registration

The canvass response rates (by December 2001) for the register published on 1st December 2001 were as follows:

Argyll & Bute 90% Coatbridge & Chryston (part) 94% Clydebank & Milngavie 89%

Dumbarton 88% Strathkelvin & Bearsden 92%

General Information:

During the year April 2001 to March 2002, the Assessor had a staff of 66, a staffing budget of £1.73M and during the last year a total of 709.5 days (4.8%) were lost through illness.
