





Council Tax:

During the year 862 houses were added to the Council Tax List. Of these, 744 (86%) were added within 3 months of the date of occupation and 835 (97%) were added within 6 months.

The target set for the year was 79% within 3 months and 94% within 6 months.

The targets set for 2001/2002 are 80% within 3 months and 96% within 6 months.





Valuation Roll:

During the year 1131 statutory amendments were made to the Valuation Roll. Of these, 459 (41%) were made within 3 months of the effective date of the alteration and 810 (72%) were made within 6 months.

The target set for the year was 42% within 3 months and 66% within 6 months.

The targets set for 2001/2002 are 45% within 3 months and 70% within 6 months.

During the year the number of entries in the Valuation Roll rose from 11,849 to 11,977 and the total rateable value rose from £167.42M to £192.8M. Around £17M of this increase was due to the change in status from exempt to rateable of a small number of former NATO properties in Argyll & Bute
