Subject: Freedom of Information

1.0 Purpose

- 1.1 To update members of the Joint Board on the ongoing requirements of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 on the Valuation Joint Board (Board) and the Assessor.
- 1.2 To seek Joint Board approval of the new Model Publication Scheme, which has been produced and approved by the Scottish Information Commissioner. It is approved until 31 May 2017.

2.0 Background

- 2.1 The Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (the Act) requires Scottish public authorities to produce and maintain a publication scheme. Authorities are under a legal obligation to:
 - publish the classes of information that they make routinely available
 - inform the public how to access the information and whether information is available free of charge or on payment.

2.2 The Guide to Information is to:

- allow you to see what information is available (and what is not available) in relation to each class.
- state what charges may be applied.
- explain how you can find the information easily.
- provide contact details for enquiries and to get help with accessing the information.
- explain how to request information we hold that has not been published.

3.0 Consultation

After extensive consultation with Information Commissioner's office and following consideration of the requirements by the Scottish Assessors Association, a Guide to Information has been drafted and is attached for Board members' consideration.

4.0 Recommendations

It is recommended that the Board approves the attached Guide and Model Publication Scheme

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
