## a. Rates per Hectare

Grassland	£3.90
Mixed	£3.75
Woodland	£6.50
Commercial Forestry	£6.50
GREATER THAN 80% COMMERCIAL FORESTRY NURSERY	
(less than 5 years old)	£1.50
GREATER THAN 80% COMMERCIAL FORESTRY FELLED	
(less than 5 years old)	£1.50
GREATER THAN 80% COMMERCIAL FORESTRY FELLED & REPLANTED	
(less than 5 years old)	£1.50

Up to 1000	0%
1000	-5%
2000	-10%
3000	-20%
4000	-30%
5000 and over	-50%
